How do I help my child develop his/her potential?

Join Dr. Moody, gifted education teacher, for a workshop on fostering your child's early interest and strengths. Strategies for embedding critical and creative problem solving and developmentally appropriate activities within your child's daily experiences will be shared along with a review of games and toys that encourage children's cognitive development.

Session 1: Google Classroom

If you went to Google and typed in a search for "Classroom", you would not find pictures of your child's class here at SMES! Instead, you would be directed to "Google Classroom". Classroom is a free web-based platform that integrates your child's Google Apps for Education account with all their Google Suite services, including Google Docs, Presentation, and Google Drive. Classroom saves time and paper, and makes it easy to create classes, distribute assignments, communicate, and stay organized.

Teachers can quickly see who has or hasn't completed the work, and provide direct, real-time feedback and grades right in Classroom.

Join Dr. Narvell as he explains and demonstrates how our students here at SMES work in Google Classroom so that parents can understand the process so you can help your child at home!

Session 2: Georgia Milestones Test Prep Tips

Join Mrs. Carter to learn some tips about how to help prepare your child for the Georgia Milestones Testing experience. Gain access to the portal so you may login and experience the test yourself as well as walking away with ideas on how to turn testing into a fun and exciting challenge for your child. Note: This is best suited for families of 3rd – 5th graders.

Session 3: Functions of Behavior

Learn about the functions of child behaviors and strategies to use from expert BCBA's, Amanda Coad and Becca Accord, from Reaching Milestones.

Session 4: Reading Strategies
